Navajo Nation Division of Social Services
FY 2017 Domestic/Family Violence Shelter and Supportive Services

The Division of Social Services, pursuant to the Navajo Nation Business Preference Act, 5 NNC § 205, et seq., is requesting for proposals from qualified shelter providers and programs to provide overnight/day and temporary shelter services for victims of family violence, domestic violence and dating violence and their dependents within the Navajo Nation and provide supportive services including operations of a 24/7 shelter facility, 24 hour crisis intervention, individual/group counseling, life skills development, referrals to community based services, advocacy, case management services, transportation, and providing an accessible 24/7 crisis hotline for victims and their dependents.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Category 1:

Certified non-profit organizations, Section 501 (c)(3) of the IRS Code located within the jurisdictional boundaries of the Navajo Nation or in an area considered near the Navajo Nation (accordance to Bureau of Indian Affairs service area definition under 25CFR Part 20.100, see Attachment E)

Category 2: Certified non-profit organizations, Section 501 (c)(3) of the IRS Code located outside of the jurisdictional boundaries of the Navajo Nation and not considered “near”.

All proposals are due October 7, 2016 at 5pm MDT. Proposals received after the deadline will not be accepted. Faxed or e-mailed proposals will not be accepted.
